1. Toothbrushes - individually wrapped for Hygiene kits and Shoe Boxes, any packaging for Guatemala, we need about 750 or so (buy anywhere, Dollar Tree sometimes has packs of 3/\$1)
2. Air Freshener spray, we need 40 (\$1 at Dollar Tree, Dollar General, etc.)
3. Clothespins, we need 40 sets of 50 (\$1 at Walmart, other places cost more)
4. Clothes Line, 50' or 100', we need 40 of 100' (\$1 for 50' lines at Dollar Tree, need 80)
